

A Message from your President:

Looking over the Bylaws of R&B, I stopped to slowly read the objectives of our club: "The objective of the Rhythm and Blues Beach Music Hall of Fame, Inc., [our chartered name] shall be to preserve, promote, and honor the rhythm and blues music sound, the shag, and the artist who contributed to our heritage." Most shag clubs have a similar objective but sometimes seem to stray. R&B is not one of those. We have carried the dance and music out into the community to promote it in such a way that does us proud. We have carried it beyond a monthly dance by providing a large dance floor for public events-First Thursday Music on Main, by sponsoring community dance sessions-Learn Our State Dance at the Marriott on March 27, by participating in charitable events-Heart Fund, Cancer Survivors Day, Mobile Meals Benefit, and many more. We truly promote and honor the objectives of our club.

Our latest promotion is the joining of the American Bop Association. This exposes shag to many more clubs of great dancers and helps to preserve our heritage as well as spreading shag beyond the Southeastern states. This year we hope to bring a lot of boppers south to enjoy and learn what we love and enjoy. Already folks from seven states outside our usual territory have ordered tickets for Sparkle City Celebration on July 24-26 at the Marriott.

R&B has been asked by the ACSC to evaluate and make recommendations concerning the Lake Lure Shag Club's application to join our association. This is an honor and will be reported on at the 2009 Spring ACSC/SOS business meeting. This is another means of supporting our heritage by helping shag clubs get organized and be successful.

Last year, we encouraged the City to invite beach music/shag bands to the Thursday Music on Main events from April through August and were successful in their bringing in our music on the first Thursday of each month. With our floor down for shaggers, the First Thursdays drew larger crowds than the other Thursday bands. We are also working hard to expand our relationships with other clubs by attending their events and by having them attend ours. Many great clubs are only a short drive away, and we can learn from each other and have a lot of fun doing it.

So, when you see club members sweating in the heat putting down and taking up the dance floor, cleaning off tables, working the door, and tending to the many other tasks associated with helping folks enjoy our music and our dance, tell them thanks and ask, "Can I help?" There are also those you don't see who are writing newsletters, handling our finances and balancing our check book, making phone calls, working our web site, handing out flyers and hundreds of other things that keep our club running. Yeah, I guess you can say we are true to our objectives, and we are dancing "with the one what brung us"—shagging the night away.


